PROMISE OF A BRIGHT TOMORROW, PART 2

(Part 2 of a 10 part series)

In Part 1, which was posted yesterday, we learned the God who spoke to Jews, Christians, and Muslims promised humanity would "...go out in joy, and be led forth in peace." (Isaiah 55:12). We noted the world is presently stuck in a downward spiral hell-bent on disaster, and the question was asked, "How do we get from the present mess we find ourselves in, to the "promised land" of joy and peace?" We'll start to answer this question, but first, something must be said about God speaking to "Jews, Christians, and Muslims".

What must be said is this: God didn't communicate with only these three groups. God has spoken to all peoples, throughout time. Trust me on this: If God only spoke to followers of those three religions, there'd be no "promised land" of joy and peace waiting for us. I meant what I said when I wrote the promise is meant for all peoples, just like the following prophecy from Isaiah indicates.

Isaiah 49:6 says when peace comes to what many call "the Holy Land", this peace and attendant benefits will spread over the entire world. So, what first benefits those in the Holy Land is only the beginning of a process of salvation that spreads everywhere. Keep in mind as you read the prophecy the "tribes of Jacob" are the Israelites, which surprisingly, includes everyone living there today, both Israelis and Palestinians. Now, here's the prophecy:

Isaiah 49:6;

"[God] says:

"It is too small a thing for you to be my servant

to restore the tribes of Jacob

and bring back those of Israel I have kept.

I will also make you a light for the Gentiles,

that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth."

When both groups of Israelites have their rights "restored" and agree to peace, God promises salvation will "reach to the ends of the earth". Not bad! Except, how is there ever going to be a peace over there where both groups get along with each other? Jesus was known to say, ""With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." (Matthew 19:26). He was right!

So, here's where the answer to "How do we get from here to there" comes in. Let's go back to the first promise: Isaiah 55:12, where God promises we'll "...go out in joy, and be led forth in peace." In the verse just prior to that, God says, "11 ...my word...will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it." God's word will serve the purpose for which it was sent: to lead us out of our dilemma in joy and peace.

Which brings us to "God's Peace Plan for the Holy Land". (You'll find the links below.)

"God's Peace Plan for the Holy Land" uses specific instructions God put into the sacred books (literally, God's "word") to guide us in how to share the land properly. In a nutshell, God calls for the Holy Land to be a single nation, with two "states", like California and New York, with Jerusalem the shared national capital. It also shows how and why all peoples presently living in the Holy Land belong there, even if some of them appear to have come from elsewhere. This knowledge is crucial, because the entire world has become entangled in this dispute and needs the ultimate referee to sort things out.

OK. So there's a peace plan. Now what? Here's what—God is encouraging you to share the peace plan far and wide! Isaiah 52:7;

7 How beautiful on the mountains

are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

When people follow the instructions God provided us, God reigns!
