

Promise of a Bright Tomorrow, Part 10B

If so, consider that to be a gift, too. But remember: All glory goes to God! Don't take credit when reproducing any part of this message. All scripture quotes are from the NIV version of the Bible.)

In Matthew 24, verse 21, Jesus prophesied;

²¹ For then there will be great distress, unequalled from the beginning of the world until now—and never to be equaled again."

The world sure has lots of distress! The Middle East and Eastern Europe are engulfed in war. Russia, China, Iran and North Korea are confronting the West, and the world is teetering on the edge of World War III. Then, there's climate change, monster hurricanes, floods, plagues, famines, and other disasters. And now, as you learned in Part 10A of the "Promise of a Bright Tomorrow" series, "The Man of Lawlessness and a Stolen Election", (2 Thessalonians 2:1-12), the election was stolen by the "man of lawlessness", Donald Trump.

I can't recall a single point in time since Jesus made the prophecy all the way up until today, when the world has been in more distress. However, before continuing, I ought to let you know there's a happy ending waiting for virtually all humanity. In Isaiah 55:12, God promised "You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace..." That promise extends to all humanity. And in Matthew 24:22, while speaking of these times of greatest distress, Jesus promised, "²² "If those days had not been cut short, no one would survive, but for the sake of the elect those days will be shortened." So, knowing the ending is happy, the purpose of this message is to help us get from the perilous "here" to the happy and secure "there".

But, if we've arrived at that time mentioned in Matthew 24, then other Bible prophecies say a few characters must also be present—a "dragon", a "beast", and a "false prophet", to name three. There's a purpose for this. In the verse preceding God's promise to lead us out of peril in Isaiah 55:12, God said this...

Isaiah 55:11;

"... ¹¹ so is my word that goes out from my mouth:
It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire
and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

In other words, God's purpose is to lead us out of our peril by using something all Christian believers can rely upon: God's word in the Bible will guide us. No way for any imposter to deceive us with lies, appearances, or charisma.

There's two kinds of guidance, one which says, "Do this", and one which says, "Don't do that". This message will focus more on "Don't do that" in the context of 2 Peter 2:1-2;

¹ But there were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. They will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the sovereign Lord who bought them—bringing swift destruction on themselves. ² Many will follow their depraved conduct and will bring the way of truth into disrepute."

It's even conceivable some well-intentioned but misguided people might tragically be duped into joining the crowd depicted in Revelation 14:11;

"¹¹ And the smoke of their torment will rise for ever and ever.

There will be no rest day or night for those who worship the beast and its image, or for anyone who receives the mark of its name."

God willing, this message will help steer believers clear of that torment!

The reason God included villain characters in the prophecies, is to steer us away from going in the direction these wicked critters are trying to lead us. Much the same way professional wrestlers have stage names like "Mauler" or "Crusher", God ascribed the titles "dragon" and "beast (and many more) to prophecy villains, who are usually (but not always) people. God does this as a means to conceal their identity until the time arrives when it serves God's purpose to reveal it, as the following example illustrates...

2 Thessalonians 2:3,8;

³ Don't let anyone deceive you in any way,
for that day will not come until the rebellion occurs
and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the man doomed to destruction.

⁸ And then the lawless one will be revealed,
whom the Lord Jesus will overthrow with the breath of his mouth..."

Following are a few examples of how God, Christ, and their servants overthrow villains with "the breath of his mouth"...

Hosea 6:5;

⁵ Therefore I cut you in pieces with my prophets,
I killed you with the words of my mouth..."

Isaiah 30:27;

"See, the Name of the Lord comes from afar,
with burning anger and dense clouds of smoke;
his lips are full of wrath, and his tongue is a consuming fire."

Examples, cont.:

Jeremiah 5:14, the Lord God Almighty:

"...“Because the people have spoken these words [or other evil acts],
I will make my words in your mouth a fire and these people the wood it consumes.”
Ephesians 6:17;

“Take...the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.”

2 Corinthians 10:4;

“The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world.
...they have divine power to demolish strongholds [and would-be dictators].”
Jeremiah 23:29;

“Is not my word like fire,” declares the Lord,
“and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?”

Revelation 2:16; Repent therefore!

Otherwise, I ...will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.”

2 Thessalonians 2:8;

⁸ And then the lawless one will be revealed,
whom the Lord Jesus will overthrow with the breath of his mouth...”

Revealed prophecies are divine weapons God uses to strike down evil, arrogant men. God does this by assigning a fake name like “dragon” or “beast” to a villain, and next describes their personal characteristics and memorable acts he or she has done. God takes this information back in time and gives it to prophets living thousands of years ago (or takes them forward in time to see it in person). The prophets put what they receive into prophecies, where it quietly sits until we arrive at the time the target villains are threatening the world’s well-being. At that point, God selects a servant to reveal who they are. I am one such servant. That’s why I’m here today. It’s time to reveal the identity of Satan and his right-hand demon, the “beast”, a.k.a. the “abomination that causes desolation”, and yes, “man of lawlessness”, too.

Before proceeding, we must take into account that God decided the meaning of the prophecies and the guidance they contain would remain hidden until the right time for it to be revealed arrived. That’s why archangel Gabriel said what he did to the prophet Daniel in Daniel 12:4;

“⁴...Daniel, close up and seal the words of the scroll until the time of the end. ...”

If God wants to seal a prophecy, decoding it won’t be easy unless you know the key. That’s because God knows how our minds think, and can say things in a way our mental tendencies will naturally lead us off on a wild goose chase. So, it will be very useful spending a few minutes to get a basic understanding of how to decode them.

The first step, is understanding for whom "End Times" prophecies are intended and why. Prophecies have the greatest value for people who will be alive at the time they are fulfilled. If the prophecy is going to be fulfilled way off in the far future, it's of no immediate benefit. But, if you're alive when the "End Times" prophecies are being fulfilled—like now—then prophecies are the means through which Creator provides us the guidance we need.

So, the prophecies are sealed with a code. That's a big reason why people have to interpret them! If they were clear and direct, we wouldn't need to interpret them. But, if the purpose is to provide guidance, it also makes sense to encode them in an easily understandable manner which provides a clear and accurate picture—once we know the "key". Giving us a "jar of guidance" with a human-proof "lid" makes no sense. So, the key to the code must be simple as pie--especially if we're in a perilous spot and it needs to be decoded quickly, so we can act upon God's guidance before it's too late. That's why Jesus said what he did in...

Matthew 11:25;

"...I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth,
because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned,
and revealed them to little children."

and Matthew 18:3;

"...Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children,
you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."

One of the two principal encoding techniques is use of figurative speech.
John 16:25, Jesus;

"Though I have been speaking figuratively, a time is coming
when I will no longer use this kind of language [figurative speech]
but will tell you plainly about my Father."

And so did the apostles...
1 Corinthians 2:13, Paul;

¹³ This is what we [the Apostles] speak,
not in words taught us by human wisdom [conventional definitions]
but in words taught by the Spirit,
expressing spiritual truths in [figurative] spiritual words."

Because "End Times" prophecies are meant for the people of today—when they are being fulfilled, they oftentimes use modern-day figures of speech (i.e., "slang"). Remember; for the prophecy to serve God's purpose, it must be written in a manner easily understandable by its target audience. "Slang" is perfect for that.

One method to encode words using figurative speech is childishly simple: Use a word to symbolize something else. Then, somewhere in scripture, place a phrase which provides us the key to the code. Here's two superb examples...

Psalms 57:4, David;

⁴ I am in the midst of lions; I lie among ravenous beasts—
men whose teeth are spears and arrows, whose tongues are sharp swords."

Jude 1:12-13;

¹² These men are...shepherds who feed only themselves. They are clouds without rain, blown along by the wind; autumn trees, without fruit and uprooted—twice dead.

¹³ They are wild waves of the sea, foaming up their shame; wandering stars, for whom blackest darkness has been reserved forever."

In Psalms 57, men are figuratively called "beasts" and "lions". Somewhere else in a prophecy you'll find "beasts" and/or "lions", and the prophecy won't make sense until you substitute "men" in their place. In Jude 1:12-13, false teachers are defined as being "clouds", "trees", "waves of the sea", and "stars". So, whenever you see these words in a prophecy, they may be code for "people". Can't get much simpler than that! That's the beauty of it. But, people try making it overly hard and complicated, and so, they overlook the simple. Paul described it thusly...

1 Corinthians 2:14, Paul;

¹⁴ The [literalist] man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned."

And then, there's Metaphorical Themes. Some major metaphorical themes found in prophecies are "Water", "Plants", "Topography", and "Heaven & Earth". We'll begin with the "Water" metaphor, where every person is a single drop of water in the collective "sea" of humanity. Revelation 17:15;

^{17:15} ...The waters you saw,...are peoples, multitudes, nations and languages."

We can also be individual drops of rain in a "cloud" made up of a crowd of people. Hebrews 12:1 is a great example of this metaphor...

^{12:1} "...since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses..."

With the "Plants" metaphor, the common, "small" people are "grass" and the rulers who loom over them are "trees". The "Topography" metaphor is similar, only here the common people are "valleys" and the rulers who loom over them are "mountains". In the "Heaven & Earth" metaphor, common people are "down to Earth", and the "heavens" and "sky" the government reigning over them. "Stars" and "heavenly bodies" are individual members of the elite, who collectively form the "heavens".

One last thing, regarding use of specific periods of "Time" in prophecy. According to the rules, a stated period of time is variable, and can be however long God wants it to be. It's according to God's standards, not ours. Here's the rule...
2 Peter 3:8;

⁸ But do not forget this one thing, dear friends:
With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day."

God making up the rules for sealing prophecies is almost unfair, but it's no use arguing. God rules! I hope this tutorial was helpful. Now, let's dive into the prophecies. Because the article must be short enough to be read quickly, and yet still have enough "meat" to have the desired impact, we'll only examine a few "beast" prophecies. There are many more, as God has done a very thorough job. So, God willing, there will be more in the future. Today, we'll first look at some highlights from Revelation 13 and Matthew 24. Then, we'll take a closer look at Revelation 13:2-8, and last, John 8:42.

In Revelation 12:9, the "dragon" or Satan, "^{12:9}...leads the whole world astray." Think for a moment: Would it be effective for Satan to lead the world astray as a ruler of a tiny country? What prestige or power does that provide a being as hungry for fame and power as Satan is known to be? Wouldn't it make more sense for him to choose a world leader from a country like the U.S.A., Russia, or China as a target for demonic possession? Please keep this in mind as you read the following pages.

Revelation 13:1, 3, 18;

¹ "The dragon stood on the shore of the sea.
And I saw a beast coming out of the sea. It had ten horns and seven heads,
with ten crowns on its horns, and on each head a blasphemous name."

³ "One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound,
but the fatal wound had been healed.

The whole world was astonished and followed the beast."

¹⁸ "This calls for wisdom. If anyone has insight, let him calculate
the number of the beast, for it is man's number. His number is 666."

The "sea" of verse 1 is defined as being "humanity" in Revelation 17:15, where we learn, "...The waters you saw, ...are peoples, ...nations and languages." So, the "dragon" and "beast" come out of humanity—they're people. Now, some may believe the "beast" is an international alliance of nations. But if this were so, please be honest and tell me; what eight nations have blasphemous names? People don't name their nations that way! If anything, they use names they think are honorable.

On the other hand, we know Satan is a fallen angel, and demonic possession is Biblical. The "beast" is Satan's right-hand man and the second-most antichrist individual. From the time of John's prophecy up to Donald Trump (who happens to be the eighth "head"), the seven heads are the corrupt and wicked rulers the "beast" spirit possessed over the ages prior to him, like Nero—who tried to exterminate early Christianity, Hitler (of course), and now, the eight and latest, Donald Trump. Now, those are truly blasphemous names!

Revelation 13:3 reads,

³ One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound,
but the fatal wound had been healed.

The whole world was astonished and followed the beast."

On July 13, 2024, at a campaign rally in Butler, Pennsylvania, Trump was shot in the left ear during a failed assassination attempt (It had to fail so the prophecy would be fulfilled.) And now, everyone is following Trump's campaign in the news. And next, we have verse 18:

^{13:18}; This calls for wisdom.

If anyone has insight, let him calculate the number of the beast, for it is man's number.
His number is 666."

Street addresses are certainly man-made. How coincidental Trump's daughter Ivanka is married to Jared Kushner, whose real estate empire's flagship property is located at **666** Fifth Avenue in New York City.

Next, we'll look at a character called "the abomination that causes desolation", from the prophecy at the beginning of the article about this being the time of greatest distress (Matthew 24:21). Six verses earlier we find...

Matthew 24:15, Jesus;

¹⁵ "So when you see standing in the holy place 'the abomination that causes desolation,' spoken of through the prophet Daniel—let the reader understand—..."

The five verses in between depict the violence in the West Bank today. Not Gaza. That's in prophecy, too, but Judea is the southern half of the West Bank. What has happened recently—prior to violence intensifying in the West Bank—that qualifies as "standing in the holy place"? (clue: Jesus knew how to say "the Temple", if that was the "holy place" he meant.) The answer: The August 29, 2024 headline of a story published by USA Today reads, "**Trump's appalling desecration of Arlington National Cemetery shows he still can't be trusted**"

In a statement made September 1, 2024, U.S. Senator Tammy Duckworth said, "Donald Trump's latest incident at Arlington National Cemetery is just another example of someone who has no idea what it means to serve anything greater than himself. Arlington National Cemetery is sacred ground for those who gave their lives to defend and protect this nation, not the backdrop for a photo op that desecrates and disrespects their service."

Matthew 24:15, Jesus;

¹⁵ "So when you see standing in [Arlington National Cemetery] 'the abomination that causes desolation [Mr. Trump's new title],' spoken of through the prophet Daniel—let the reader understand—..."

REVELATION 13:2-8

Revelation 13:2-8, as is;

² The beast I saw resembled a leopard, but had feet like those of a bear and a mouth like that of a lion. The dragon gave the beast his power and his throne and great authority. ³ One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound, but the fatal wound had been healed. The whole world was astonished and followed the beast. ⁴ Men worshiped the dragon because he had given authority to the beast, and they also worshiped the beast and asked, "Who is like the beast? Who can make war against him?" ⁵ The beast was given a mouth to utter proud words and blasphemies and to exercise his authority for forty-two months. ⁶ He opened his mouth to blaspheme God, and to slander his name and his dwelling place and those who live in heaven. ⁷ He was given power to make war against the saints and to conquer them. And he was given authority over every tribe, people, language and nation. ⁸ All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb..."

Revelation 13:2-8, Decoded;

² **The beast I saw resembled a leopard,..."**

[*A leopard is a big yellow "pussy" cat with black spots. The color yellow represents cowardice, which Trump displayed by dodging the draft with a doctor's note claiming he had "bone spurs". (Yet they never interfered with his golfing.) The black spots represent his countless sins.]*

² cont.: "...but had feet like those of a bear and a mouth like that of a lion. ..."

[*Russia's symbol is the bear. "feet like those of a bear" represents the Russian election meddling that enabled Trump to walk into the White House in 2016, and again in 2024. And Trump constantly "roars like a lion" at the press and his opponents.]*

Revelation 13:2-8, Decoded, continued;

13:2 cont.:

The dragon gave the beast his power and his throne and great authority."

[*Russia launched a massive disinformation campaign via right-wing media and the internet. As a result, Trump won the election and became Putin's puppet. So, yes, Putin is the unlucky human Satan chose to possess...*

In John 14:30, Jesus said,

"I will not say much more to you, for the prince of this world is coming..."

If you translated the underlined part into Russian, Jesus said...

"I will not say much more to you, for Vladimir is coming..."

From <https://babynames.com/name/vlad> : "Vlad" is, "...a male name of Slavic origin that means Prince". From <https://nameberry.com/babynames/vladimir> : "...Vladimir [means] "...ruler of the world". God has plans for Putin/Satan, too!]

13:3 One of the heads of the beast seemed to have had a fatal wound, but the fatal wound had been healed.

The whole world was astonished and followed the beast."

[*We covered this two pages ago. Verse 3 details the failed assassination attempt on July 13, 2024, at a campaign rally in Butler, Pennsylvania, and now, everyone is following Trump's campaign antics in the news.]*

13:4 Men worshiped the dragon because he had given authority to the beast, and they also worshiped the beast and asked, "Who is like the beast? Who can make war against him?"

[*American Christians who should know better support Putin's war of aggression because Satan's puppet, Donald Trump, tells them they should. Of course he does! Putin's/Satan's dark money and disinformation machine is what put Trump in power. And now, despite virtually all the polls saying the race was neck and neck, shazam!!! The "counterfeit miracle" of an illegitimate "Red Wave". In despair, downhearted Democrats say, "Who is like Trump? Who can beat him?"...]*

13:5 The beast was given a mouth to utter proud words and blasphemies and to exercise his authority for forty-two months."

[*While verse 5 hasn't occurred yet, it's likely one of two things: 1) Barring a miracle, Trump will utter proud words and blasphemies right up to his dying day 42 months into his crippled presidency. Or, 2) God will defeat him before he takes office, and this is how long his term would have been if he'd actually become president.]*

father of lies

John 8:42, Jesus:

When [Satan, a.k.a. Vladimir Putin] lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies."

John 8:42, Jesus, slightly amended:

When [Donald Trump, a.k.a. the "beast"] lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the ["son" of the father] of lies."

The "father of lies" is Satan, a.k.a. the "dragon", a.k.a. Vladimir Putin. His "son" is Donald Trump. We'll cover the "son", first. If you don't already know how proficient and prolific a liar Donald Trump is, you may be offline and living on a remote desert island. In that case you probably won't be reading this. Otherwise, you already know he's one of the biggest liars you've ever encountered, whether you like him, hate him, are willing to overlook his lying, or even admire his extraordinary talent for it. Trump can never match the champion "father of lies"!

And then, there's the whoppers Putin tells all by himself:

In 2014 Putin claimed the "little green men" who invaded Crimea weren't Russians.

In 2022, he claimed he had no intention of attacking Ukraine while he massed and prepositioned his army prior to the invasion. He claims Russia isn't invading Ukraine—it's defending Russia from an invasion by NATO, despite the fact NATO is a defensive alliance and has made no move to attack. And the invasion of Ukraine? It isn't a war, it's a "*special* military operation".

Through his mouthpieces in the Russian military and state television Putin lies while he claims Russian artillery and aircraft attack only military targets, and carefully avoid hurting civilians. ¹⁶ But to the wicked, God says:

"What right have you to recite my laws or take my covenant on your lips?"

¹⁷ You hate my instruction and cast my words behind you.

¹⁸ When you see a thief, you join with him; you throw in your lot with adulterers."

[*Both Putin and Trump are thieves and adulterers, with long histories of extortion and theft, and marital infidelity. Despite this, the worshipers of the "dragon" and "beast" just can't seem to get enough of them. Pure idol worship.]*

¹⁹ You use your mouth for evil and harness your tongue to deceit.

²⁰ You speak continually against your brother and slander your own mother's son."

[*We're all God's children. So, when you despise immigrants or blaspheme against other religions you know nothing about—you do all these.]*

²¹ These things you have done and I kept silent;
you thought I was altogether like you.

But I will rebuke you and accuse you to your face.

²² "Consider this, you who forget God, or I will tear you to pieces,
with none to rescue..."

Revelation 14:9-11;

⁹ ..."If anyone worships [Donald Trump] and his image
and receives his mark on the forehead [bright red "MAGA" cap]
or on the hand [so you can get back in if you leave one of his rallies],

¹⁰ he, too, will drink of the wine of God's fury,
which has been poured full strength into the cup of his wrath.

He will be tormented with burning sulfur in the presence of the holy angels
and of the Lamb.

¹¹ And the smoke of their torment rises for ever and ever.

There is no rest day or night for those who worship the beast and his image,
or for anyone who receives the mark of his name."

Matthew 7:21-23, Jesus;

²¹ "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

²² Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name,'

[...that Putin will prevail and Trump is a modern-day "Cyrus"...]

..."and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?"

[claim to "save" souls while they served the "beast"]

²³ Then I will tell them plainly,

'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!'"

Matthew 10:25-27, Jesus;

²⁵ ...If the head [Putin] of the house [Kremlin] has been called Beelzebub, how much more the members of his [political apparatus] household!

²⁶ "So do not be afraid of them.

There is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed, or hidden that will not be made known.

²⁷ What I tell you in the dark, speak in the daylight; what is whispered in your ear, proclaim from the roofs."

Isaiah 58:1;

"Shout it aloud, do not hold back. Raise your voice like a trumpet."

Daniel 12:3, Gabriel;

Those who are wise will shine like the brightness of the heavens, and those who lead many to righteousness, like the stars for ever and ever."
